Lambeth's Labour councillors have given planning permission for Woodgate Towers – a massive tower-block development up to 14-storeys high on the site of Homebase.

Labour ignored objections from over 1,500 local people to back the plans – with the profits all going to US and Chinese investment companies.

Labour's ward councillors said they would fight it – but they failed. One of them even jumped ship, moving to Sussex to seek a parliamentary seat, but without telling anyone for months.

The only accountability has come from Streatham's Green councillors. We need a strong opposition to hold Lambeth to account.
